As per letter No. NAAC/DO/O.U/2019-20 dated 6th November, 2019 from Prof. S C Sharma, Director, National Assessment and Accreditation Council, it has been stated that Assessment and Accreditation of all Universities is mandatory and we have to submit the Online IIQA to undergo the process of Assessment and Accreditation by NAAC at the earliest.


involved in. And he encouraged everyone to swear to truly contribute to innovation.

The stakeholders in higher education play a vital role in the assessment process of the institution. Several governmental bodies like University Grants Commission and National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) established as an autonomous body with the objectives of assessment of the Higher Education Institutions in the country assesses and accredits HEIs by studying and analyzing various parameters towards the quality measures.

As per new methodology of NAAC accreditation, preparation of documentation of NAAC is complex. So to know about the preparation of NAAC documentation, a Four day online FDP on “*Mentoring for NAAC’s Assessment and Accreditation*” organized by **Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Open University** in association with **Commonwealth Educational Media Center for Asia (CEMCA), New Delhi** on 19th, 20th, 22nd October & 2nd November 2020 under the mentorship of **Prof. (Dr.) V. Venkaiah**, Senior Consultant for Quality Assurance, CEMCA, New Delhi. The objective of this FDP was to know the new process of NAAC and to understand the documentation work to be prepared for NAAC. The faculties of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Open University participated with great enthusiasm. Total 50 faculties attended the workshop with great interest via Google Meet platform.

Day-1: 19th October 2020

The Inaugural session started at 11:30 A.M. under the presence of esteemed personalities. The welcome address was given by **Prof. (Dr.) Nilesh Modi**, Professor & Director, and Coordinator of Center for Internal Quality Assurance (CIQA) & NAAC, Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Open University. Thereafter, Hon’ble. Vice Chancellor. **Prof. (Dr.) Ami Upadhyay** addressed faculty participants and resource persons with her motivating speech. She also spoke on Importance of IQAC in Higher Educational Institutions and Importance of Accreditation in Educational Institutions. **Prof. (Dr.) V. Thereafter, Hon’ble. Vice Chancellor. **Prof. (Dr.) Ami Upadhyay** addressed faculty participants and resource persons with her motivating speech. She also spoke on the importance of IQAC in Higher Educational Institutions and the importance of Accreditation in Educational Institutions. **Prof. (Dr.) V. Venkaiah**, Former Vice Chancellor, Krishna University, Hyderabad

and Academic Consultant, CEMCA-COL appreciated the program and addressed the importance of standards of HEIs. He emphasized maintaining high standards and quality in HEIs. He said NAAC accreditations are now mandatory for all HEIs. He also gave in depth knowledge of Learner Support Services and Qualitative Metrics of Criterion-5: Learner Support and Progression. He guided all participants about provisions of learner support services by the University at different levels, promotional activities done by university for prospective learners, academic counseling services, Addressing learners' grievances etc.

Day-2: 14th December 2020

Prof. (Dr.) V. Venkaiah conducted sessions wherein he talked about Best practices in ODL and Qualitative and Quantitative Metrics of Criterion-7: Institutional Values and Best Practices. He talked about what the university does for the society at large and best practices can be related to any criteria-7. While talking about Criterion 7, he explained the process of students' satisfaction survey in-detail. He told us to look at dissatisfaction more than satisfaction ratings and to identify the weakest link or bottleneck. He differentiated between feedback and survey and reasons for taking the feedback. All the participants actively participated in all three sessions and got their doubts solved by interacting with the session experts.


Day-3: 15th December 2020

He explained the infrastructural requirements and maintenance of the campus and emphasized on the idea of a language lab: a standalone language lab and foreign languages lab. He also talked about licensed software and other learning facilities. In Quantitative Metrics of Criteria-5 for Learner Support and Progression, he talked about concepts of monetary support for students and capacity enhancement, grievance support, POSH committee, Placement, Transfer certificate and Migration certificate through ERP. All the participants actively participated in all three sessions and got their doubts solved by interacting with the session experts.

Day-4: 16th December 2020

As part of the last day of the FDP, **Prof. (Dr.) V. Venkaiah** talked about the preparation of documents at the time of Peer team. All the participants were trained to work on discussion forums. The FDP concluded after the interactive session where queries of the participants was answered by the expert. All participants were very enthusiastic and were filled with zeal. They were curious and participative throughout the course of the event. It concluded with excellent feedback and positive response from all participants as they found the sessions to be insightful, informative, inspiring and enriching. FDP Report on “Quality Issues, Perspectives and Strategies for NAAC” (26-28 February 2020)

In recent years, there are a lot of technical advancements in higher education with an emphasis on quality teaching-learning. NAAC has framed benchmarks for quality education in higher educational Institutes. In this scenario, it is mandatory for all institutes to strive for quality enhancement. It is mandatory for all institutes to be NAAC accredited.

The stakeholders in higher education play a vital role in the assessment process of the institution. Several governmental bodies like University Grants Commission and National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) established as an autonomous body with the objectives of assessment of the Higher Education Institutions in the country assesses and accredits HEIs by studying and analyzing various parameters towards the quality measures.

In order to know about NAAC process, a three day online FDP on “*Quality Issues, Perspectives and Strategies for NAAC*” organized by **Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Open University** in association with **Commonwealth Educational Media Center for Asia (CEMCA), New Delhi** during 26-28 February 2020 under the mentorship of **Prof. (Dr.) V. Venkaiah**, Senior Consultant for Quality Assurance, CEMCA, New Delhi. The objective of this FDP was to understand the quality issues and strategies for the NAAC process. The faculties of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Open University participated with great enthusiasm. Total 50 faculties attended the workshop with great interest via Google Meet platform.

Day-1: 26th February 2020

The Inaugural session started at 9:30 A.M. under the presence of esteemed personalities. The welcome address was given by **Prof. (Dr.) Nilesh Modi**, Professor & Director, and Coordinator of Center for Internal Quality Assurance (CIQA) & NAAC, Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Open University. Thereafter, Hon'ble. Vice Chancellor. **Prof. (Dr.) Ami Upadhyay** addressed the core team, faculty participants and resource person with her motivating speech. She also spoke on Importance of IQAC in Higher Educational Institutions and Importance of Accreditation in Educational Institutions. **Prof. (Dr.) V. Venkaiah**, Former Vice Chancellor, Krishna University, Hyderabad and Academic Consultant, CEMCA-COL appreciated the program and addressed the importance of standards of HEIs. He emphasized maintaining high standards and quality in HEIs. He said NAAC accreditations are now mandatory for all HEIs. He explained the present

framework of assessment and accreditation for open university provides the quality keys based on parameters such as core values of the institution, national contribution, fostering global competencies, inculcating value system, promoting use of ICT and Quest for excellence. The rating and ranking of higher education institutions is of interest to all stake-holders particularly institutions because (i) they will get funds from University Grants Commission and other bodies. There is a three level accreditation processes that would be more ICT enabled with Student Satisfaction Survey and Data Verification and Validation adding value to the process. The assessment process will be carried out in three stages- Self Study Report (SSR), Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) and the Peer Team Report.

Day-2: 27th February 2020

Prof. (Dr.) V. Venkaiah conducted sessions wherein he talked about Quantitative Metrics of Criteria 1 Curricular Aspects and Criteria 2 Teaching Learning Evaluation. This is extremely important from the point of view of open universities as they get to design and develop their own curriculum. He felt that when one changes their outlook towards things, their thought process also changes. He believes that the basic mantra for every institution should be the ‘focus on quality’ as it would lead to the growth of the individual's institution and the entire society. According to him, the 7-letter words QUALITY make up the 7 criteria for assessing the institutions. This aspect should focus on the outcome rather than on input and process. He highlighted the difference between outcome and output and encouraged out of the box thinking. He also elaborated on the performance indicators of World University Rankings which comprise of Teaching (30%), Research (30%), Citations (30%), International Outlook (7.5%) and Industry Income (2.5%).

Day-3: 28th February 2020

Further speaking about the Qualitative and Quantitative Indicators across Criteria, **Prof. (Dr.) V. Venkaiah** explained Criteria-1 and Criteria-2 in depth and discussed the points institutions need to pay attention to. While talking about the Criterion 1 that is, Curriculum design and development, he pointed out that one should ‘Reboot and Rethink’ about the valuable education and Quality improvement’ in each step and department. He also talked about core and non-core indicators. In Curriculum design and revision, he highlighted the importance of experiential learning and 12 Credit wise courses. He also mentioned that teachers should pay attention to what choices are offered to the students while selecting the extra credit courses. While introducing new courses, what new and updated knowledge pointers are incorporated? Such points are giving strength to the college.

Criterion 2 Teaching Learning and Evaluation was explained at length by him. He said that Input and output are cyclical in nature. This criterion stresses upon quality of teachers as well as evaluation process and reforms in the internal evaluation. According to the eminent speaker, student’s performance and learning outcomes are interrelated. He also highlighted FQ and FE calculations for faculty quality and experience and achieving a suitable ratio of FQE were the

major pointers of discussion.

The FDP concluded after the interactive session where queries of the participants were answered by the expert. All participants were very enthusiastic and were filled with zeal. It concluded with excellent feedback and positive response from all participants as they found the sessions to be insightful, informative, inspiring and enriching. The session ended by congratulating all the staff members for their unstinted support and dedication. In the valedictory session, all the participants shared their learning experience with experts. The FDP was presided over by Hon'ble Vice Chancellor **Shri Prof. (Dr.) Ami Upadhyay** ended with the President's remarks. She congratulated all the participants and speakers for being a part of the FDP. At the end of the workshop, **Dr. Nilesh Modi** (Coordinator, CIQA & NAAC) gave a vote of thanks. The core team along with experts visited all departments of the university.

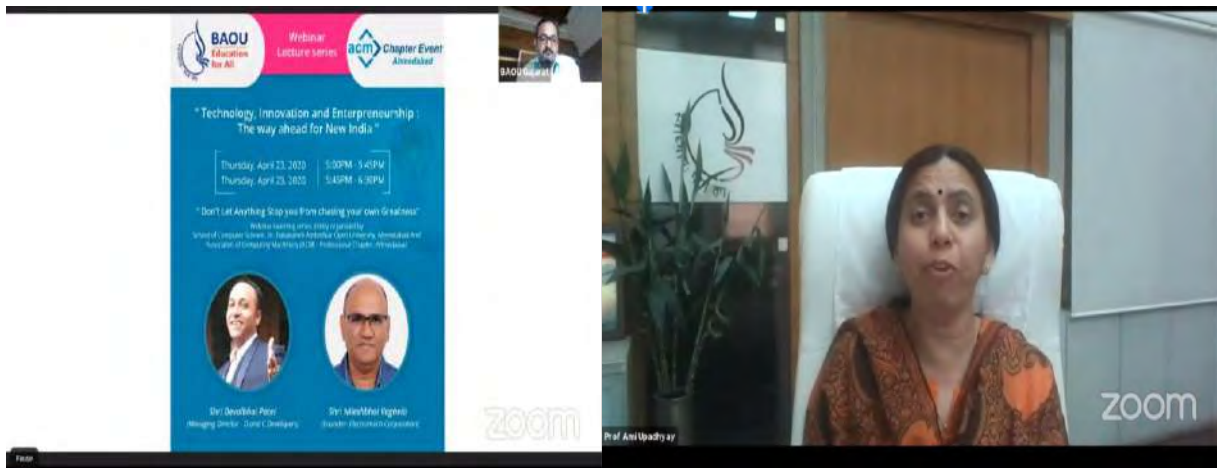

- ૨) સ્વયમ અભ્યાસક્રમ MODULE WISE તૈયાર કરવાના રહેશે.
- ૩) દરેક MODULEમાં Syllabusનો એક સેક્શનનો સમાવેશ કરવાનું રહેશે.
- ૪) દરેક લેક્ચર વીડિઓ ૨૫-૩૦ મિનીટનો રહેશે.
- ૫) સ્વયમ અભ્યાસક્રમનો સમયગાળો લગભગ ૮-૧૨ અઠવાડિયાનો હોય છે.
